### Morning Drop off

### Afternoon Collection (Rear of School)

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## Attendance & Term Time Leave

This academic year, we urge all parents not to arrange holidays during term time, as this results in children missing vital education.

Absences for term time holidays will not be authorised, unless they are exceptional circumstances, and fixed penalty notices will be issued by the local authority where applicable.

The trigger for a fixed penalty notice is 5 full school days (10 sessions – morning & afternoon registration) which do not have to be consecutive.

Should you require term time leave for exceptional circumstances, only requests via the official form will be considered. This form is available on the website or by contacting the office.

## Fixed Penalty Notice Information

The amount of the penalty is £60 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days.

If the payment is after 21 days but within a maximum 28 days, the penalty payment is £120 per parent/carer.

If the fixed penalty notice remains unpaid, the file is passed to the Authorities Legal Services and the parent/carer could be prosecuted in the Magistrates Court.

By law, the school must collect and report details of absences as attendance is a performance indicator. We monitor attendance on a weekly basis, so will identify any children whose attendance and punctuality are a cause for concern. Parents will be contacted individually if required.

Attendance inspections from Cheshire West & Chester Council are required during each academic year. Children showing attendance below 96% at the time of inspection will trigger involvement from the local authority Educational Welfare Officer, who will request a detailed explanation from school regarding the nature of the absences.
