We try our best at everything we do


We support and encourage each other

## What are the consequences for not following the Rainbow Rules and School Rules?

### Step 1

Positive praise given to those who are behaving appropriately.

### Step 2

Verbal warning given with reasoning.

### Step 3

Warning given with reasoning.

### Step 4

If a child receives **3 'warnings'** in a week, parents will be informed via a phone call from their class teacher. They will also miss their next break (maximum 15 minutes), during which time they will be asked to **'reflect'** on any inappropriate behaviour, supported by the relevant Key Stage Lead.
