### Nut Free School

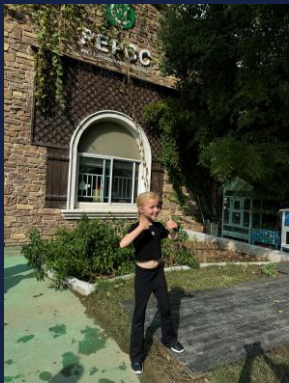
