Attendance Reporting

Please be aware the local authority has introduced new statutory returns that school are legally required to provide. Please see below an extract from the information we have been provided:

Statutory Returns

Please be reminded that in guidance, 'Working Together to Improve School Attendance' all schools are legally required to share information from their registers with the local authority. This includes:

- **Attendance Return** – providing the local authority with the names and addresses of all pupils of compulsory school age, who fail to attend school regularly or, have been absent for a continuous period of 10 school days and the absence is unauthorised and recorded as code G, N, O and or U. These returns should be made on a monthly basis. We will soon be issuing details of how you can do this and agree some dates for the returns.
- **Sickness Return** – providing the local authority with the names and addresses of all pupils of compulsory school age, who have been recorded with code I (illness), who have or will, miss 15 days consecutively or cumulatively because of sickness (illness). Only one sickness return is required for a continuous period of sickness in a school year.

G – Family Holiday (not authorised) / N – No reason provided / O – Absent in other or unknown circumstances / U – Late after register closes (9am)
