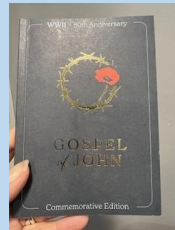

May Half Term – Sports Coaching Group Holiday Camp (Tues 27th – Fri 30th May inc)

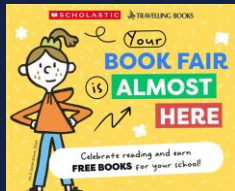
