This week has seen the conclusion to this year's swimming. The children have shown excellent progress and thoroughly enjoyed their lessons.



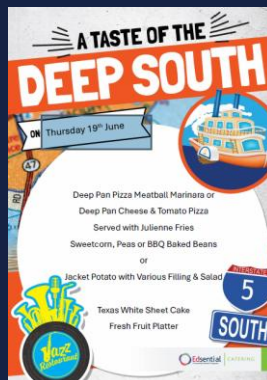
Key Stage 2 Athletics Event – Wednesday 18th June – 3pm collection
