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Sports Day – 8th July 2025 (Morning only)

Next Tuesday sees our Key Stage 2 sports day take place.

The session will commence straight after morning registration until approx. 11.30am. Please drop your child off as normal before making your way to the playing field. The gate will be open for you to gain entry.

Parking is available at the rear of school on the car park area, or at The Bells of Peover, both their main car park and overflow areas. If you are parking at The Bells, please ensure your car is removed by 11.45am ready for their lunchtime business. As it will be very busy around school, please consider a car share if possible.

Please can we ask that you do not park on The Cobbles, in front of Church, or block any access to school or our neighbouring properties – thank you. No parking is permitted on the school field. Please do not block the playground gate.

There is no seating available, so please bring a camping chair if you need/want to sit – thank you.

If you are able to stay for a drink and/or lunch at The Bells to support them, we would appreciate it. They are extremely kind to allow us to use their car park for school events. Thank you

Parent Consultation Evenings – Tuesday 8th & Wednesday 9th July

Parent consultation evenings will take place for those parents requesting an appointment next week. For parents attending, a reminder that this is an appointment with the teacher only. Books will not be available to view – thank you

Wraparound care will be operating out of the Reception classroom. Please enter via the main entrance to school to collect your children from the classroom. As parents evening will be finished at approx. 5.30pm, wraparound care will then move back to the hall to assist in easier collection from the main entrance. Once the doors are closed, please ring the wraparound care bell for assistance.

SCG Sport Clubs will run as normal, and all children will either be outside on the front loop (with any wraparound siblings) or in wraparound care if you have booked them in.

Year 6 Leavers Service – Chester Cathedral – Wednesday 9th July 2025

A reminder that Year 6 will be attending their leavers service at Chester Cathedral next Wednesday. Please ensure they have a packed lunch and drink with them, **in a disposable bag** (no lunchboxes or water bottles).

Please can the children wear their summer uniform (**no leavers hoodies please**), and they will also need a waterproof coat in case of bad weather. We will return to school in time for afternoon collection.

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Lower Moss Wood – Birds of Prey (Owls) Treat – 10th & 17th July 2025

We have arranged for Lower Moss Wood to visit school and bring a selection of their owls to show the children. This will be split into Reception & Key Stage 1 classes on Thursday 10th July, followed by Key Stage 2 classes on Thursday 17th July.

If we could ask for donations of wet and dry cat food and/or wild bird seed to be brought into school, we can pass them onto Lower Moss Wood for their wildlife hospital. Whilst we are not specifically asking for monetary donations, should you wish to send your child/children in with £1 it will certainly help them continue to provide their wonderful service.

If the animal food items and/or any cash donations could be brought in on each of the dates mentioned above only, we would appreciate it.
