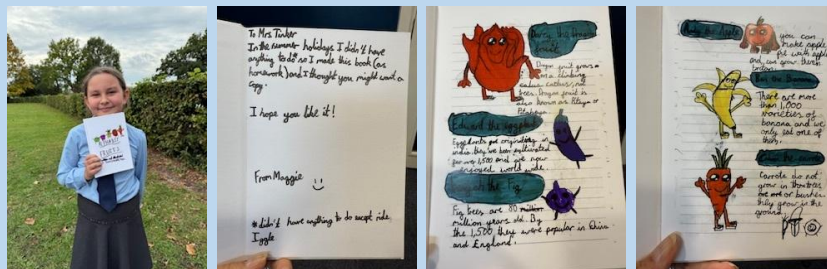


Weekly Newsletter Friday 3rd October 2025
